

# ENCORE offers a variety of merit scholarship, financial aid, and work-study opportunities for Summer Academy's solo young artists.

### **Resident Assistant Scholarship**

ENCORE Resident Assistants serve as supervisors in the residence halls, supporting and guiding fellow students. RA positions are open to solo young artists aged 18 and above, with a \$2,000 scholarship.

Applicants are considered based on experience and demonstrated financial need. To apply, students submit a statement of interest along with a résumé highlighting relevant experience through the online application. RA duties are designed so they do not interfere with scheduled activities or practice time.

#### · Resident Assistant Responsibilities:

- · Check in and check out students
- · Arrive one day prior to the start of the Academy
- · Conduct curfew checks on a rotating basis
- Enforce all Academy policies including concert attendance



The 2026 ENCORE Summer Academy will take place for the first time on the campus of Baldwin Wallace University's Conservatory of Performing Arts in Berea, OH — a nationally ranked institution with 125 years of history dedicated to inspiring students of all ages to explore, understand, and realize authentic artistic expression.

Since its 2024 expansion into a full Conservatory of Performing Arts, BW has further elevated the performing arts on campus, encompassing its distinctive programs in theatre, dance, and arts management and entrepreneurship.

Students will be housed in air-conditioned, double-occupancy dorms, supervised by student and staff Resident Assistants. Underage students will have a curfew, and all students are expected to adhere to campus guidelines to ensure a safe and supportive environment.
